Applicant Criteria

- Must be enrolled member of the Gros-Ventre or Assiniboine Tribe
- Attending a nationally or regionally accredited higher education institution in the United States
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher

Essay Questions (Double spaced, typed, 12 pt. font only)

The application requires essay questions that are listed below. This is an opportunity to tell your story and demonstrate your writing skills. Answer the following questions in a separate document and include the question in each essay answer:

- ✓ **Introduction** – Introduce yourself in the Aaniih or Nakoda language (not mandatory) and in English. Include information about your family and community. (minimum of 100 words)
- ✓ **What steps are you taking to reach your short and long-term educational goals?** (minimum of 100 words)
- ✓ **What is your definition of leadership? What important values does a good leader demonstrate?** Describe current or past leadership experiences that you have or have had, including any lessons learned about leadership. (Minimum of 300 words)
- ✓ **Who past or present has taught you, been a role model, or inspired you to become a leader? How have they done so?** (Minimum of 300 words)
- ✓ **In what ways have you contributed to your community? What has been your most significant contribution?** (Minimum of 300 words)
- ✓ **Describe a personal challenge(s) you have faced in your life? How did you overcome this challenge?** (Minimum of 300 words)
- ✓ **Describe your life five years after completing your degree. What is your vision for the future? How will the IMDGSF scholarship help you attain your goals?** (Minimum of 300 words)
